- 21 February, 7:00 AM - Breakfast next door at the Cracker Barrel Restaurant or in motel lobby

9:30 AM – Raptor talk, demo's, plus Q&A period for general public
9:30 AM – Falconers, all VFA members, & invited guests *only* form hunting parties

6:45 PM - VFA Banquet at the Chinatown Restaurant* @1085 on Rt.50 (East of Rt.81)

Notes:

- (1) There will be several sites reserved for hunting on Saturday and directions will be handed out Saturday morning. It strongly suggests attendees arrive on Friday in time to find hunting sites and acquire permission to hunt.
- (2) The Board requests that those attending the meet sign the sheet on the VFA Headquarters' door (Room 336), and also indicate in its center column the number of people in your group that will attend the Saturday banquet.
- (3) Your raptor type and all quarry taken during the meet should also be indicated on the other sheet provided in Room 336. If the quarry is taken on Sunday or after your or their departure, please inform the Meet Director, Gene Stevans, by e-mail at gstevans@aol.com or by cell phone at (703) 627-1871.
